About the programme

This is an applied diploma (120 credits) requiring the learner to complete 200 hours of practical work. The programme is centred on developing the competencies needed to support client's complex needs. The learning is transferred into work practices.

The diploma includes developing and recognising the following competencies:

- Being client-focused, working independently and continuously improving.
- Working alongside tangata whenua.
- Working with people from diverse cultures and backgrounds.
- Specific skills, knowledge, attributes and statutory responsibilities required for the role.
- Understanding relevant developments in Aotearoa.
