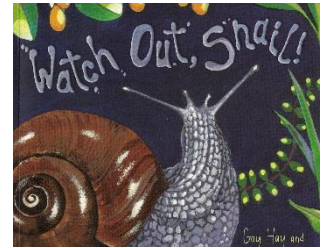


Marlborough Museum Natural History Week – 20 – 24 January 2020
