A member of the public notified council of wastewater overflowing from a manhole outside 23 Birdling Close (circled green below).



From there it flowed, via the stormwater system, into the creek (shown by the red arrow in the diagram below) and from there eventually into the Beach Rd stormwater drain.



The partial blockage was most likely caused by tree root intrusion into the sewer. This was cleared by 22:00.
