The services encompass the following job functions:

 Description: Works within the Picton and Waikawa urban areas to ensure a high density of predator trapping.

Planning

- mapping trap placement positions.
- maintaining adequate trapping stock for shop sales.
- liaising, as necessary, with landowners within the postcode 7220 area, and obtaining suitable permissions and permits
- sourcing suitable volunteers and employees as required for Garden Trapping activities.

Maintenance

- offering a service to householders and/or gardeners who wish to trap but are unable to maintain the traps themselves
- ensuring householders have a high level of confidence in the integrity of any visiting PDC representative, knowing their privacy and property will be respected at all time
- ensuring a detailed history of the trapping results is maintained, allowing for the analysis of catch data from, and presenting the catch analysis to the GM
- ensure trap conditions are maintained by regular surveys with owners and trappers

General

- Arrange and lead all Garden Trapping Working Group meetings
- promoting garden trapping in the town
- liaising with garden trappers.
- o reporting each month to the GM.
- o participating in the annual review of the field health and safety policy.
- providing advice or input for grant applications and sponsorship opportunities.
- providing advice or input to communications activities including newsletters, social media, website, and public presentations and functions.
